

Dear Parents of Incoming First Graders,

Welcome to first grade. Here are some important activities to do over the summer to prepare your child for the upcoming year:

- **Practice pre-primer and primer Dolch words** (*word sheets attached*).
  - Step 1 Ask your child to say each word aloud. Stop when your child has missed words.
  - Step 2 Make flashcards for those words.
  - Step 3 When your child has mastered those words, ask your child the next group of words.
  - Step 4 When he/she misses five words, make flashcards for those five.
  - Step 5 Once/week review the mastered words. What they haven't retained, put back in the current flashcards.
  - Step 6 Continue this process through the pre-primer and primer words.
- **Practice addition and subtraction facts 0 – 10**
- **Practice tying shoes**

We're looking forward to meeting you and your first grader in August. Have a wonderful summer.
