HOW-TO PROJECT

OBJECTIVE: Each student will prepare a poster that shows how to do or make something. The five parts of a “How-to” must be included. The poster must be a regular poster board that you can easily display in the hallway with tacks. Foam or tri-fold corrugated poster boards will not be accepted.

***A video or power point may be done in addition to the poster.

PARTS OF A “HOW-TO”:

TITLE: What the article is about

INTRODUCTION or PURPOSE: What you will make or do (2 SENTENCES)

WHAT YOU NEED: **COMPLETE** list of all the materials needed to complete the “How-to”, also called “Materials”

STEPS: Numbered list of what to do to make the “How-to”

CONCLUSION: Names your new creation or task you have accomplished; might give tips for other ways to do the activity or explain how the finished product or task may help others. (2 SENTENCES)

THE PROJECT:

This project will be in the form of a poster. Projects can be typed or handwritten and then glued onto the poster. Make sure all five parts are included. Drawings or photographs are encouraged. A power point or video can be submitted in addition to the poster.

Pictures of the finished project should be included in the report. Bring in one example to show the class. **NO FOOD ITEMS or PAPER AIRPLANES ARE PERMITTED**

Each student should be prepared to share and explain his project.
